New delivery trucks to aid food banks

Forgotten Harvest and Gleaners Community Food Bank of Southeastern Michigan said Thursday that JP Morgan Chase is to donate three state-of-the-art food delivery trucks to provide the area's hungry people with fresh fruits and vegetables. Estimates indicate that the trucks will help move more than 4 million pounds of food per year in the metro area.

Chase announced the donation as part of a \$5-million national grant to Feeding America and its nationwide network of food banks.

According to a recent U.S. Department of Agriculture study, nearly 4 million households in Michigan faced hunger in 2008.
